4-H Camp is the perfect place to make new friends, hang out with old friends and cabin mates, learn something new like kayaking or disc golf, cook on a campfire, learn to swim, jump off a diving board, and learn how to do the famous camp activity-“Sally Down the Alley.”

You will stay in a cabin with adult leaders from Hancock County. Parents, this means you! We need adult volunteers to attend camp with us. The 4-H Council pays ½ the camper price for 1 camper with each adult attending camp. All adults must be processed and approved by the Client Protection Committee. There is no charge for adults to attend camp.

Teen Leaders are 15-17 years old and are also needed to help with camp. The Teen Leader fee is \$163 and community service hours are awarded. You can participate in the fundraisers for your camp fee.

Camp registration opens March 15th. A Camp Reservation form must be returned with the \$150 deposit. The camper fee is \$325 BUT do not let that scare you away. The 4-H Council offers scholarships, United Way gives a donation for scholarships, the Sunshine Circle Homemakers Club gives scholarships, and there will be 2 fundraisers you can do that will directly reduce your own camp fee. (There is a possibility some or all of your camp deposit will be returned to you if your fundraisers and scholarships cover the fee.)

4-H Camp is open to any youth who is currently in 3rd -8th grades. You do not have to be a 4-H Club member to attend. Please email Lisa or call 270-927-6618 for more information or any questions.

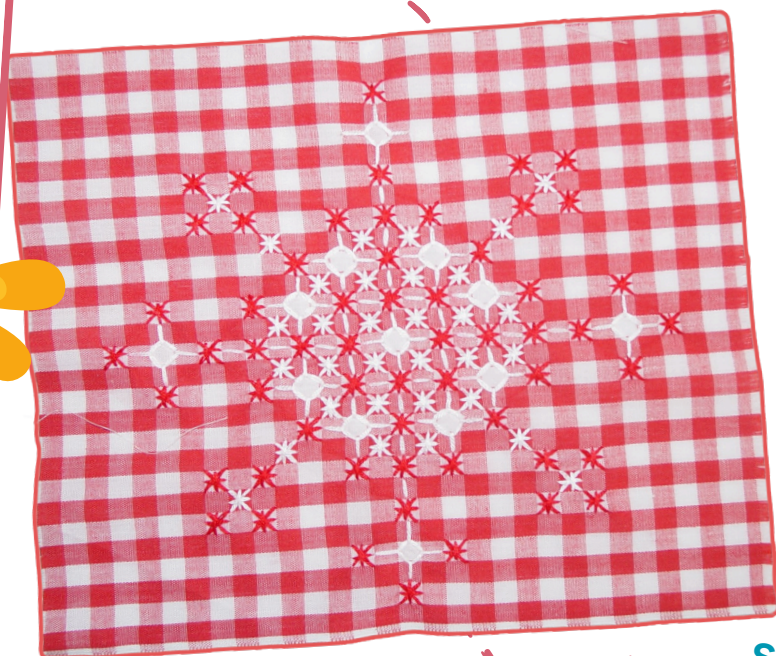

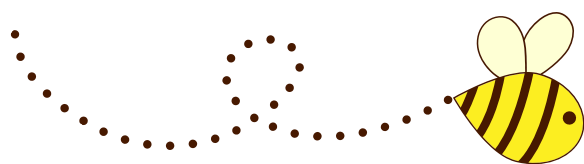
