Summer and warm weather cannot be here quick enough! 4-H Camp is July 8th-11th and will be the best week of the summer. We camp at West Ky 4-H Camp in Dawson Springs with other campers from Caldwell, Lyon, Livingston, and Crittenden Counties.

4-H Camp is the perfect place to make new friends, hang out with old friends and cabin mates, learn something new like kayaking or disc golf, cook on a campfire, learn to swim, jump off a diving board, and learn how to do the famous camp activity-“Sally Down the Alley.”

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Camp registration is OPEN. A Camp Reservation form must be returned with the \$165 deposit. The camper fee is \$325 BUT do not let that scare you away. The 4-H Council offers scholarships, United Way gives a donation for scholarships, the Sunshine Circle Homemakers Club gives scholarships, and there will be 2 fundraisers you can do that will directly reduce your own camp fee. (There is a possibility some or all of your camp deposit will be returned to you if your fundraisers and scholarships cover the fee.)
